Any Finalist who fails to attend this ceremony will forfeit their award.

Application Requirements and Rules

- *Deadline for Application: Received by May 30^{th} , 2020.
- *All contestants ages will be applied as of May 30th, 2020.

- All contestants must perform from memory in the Final Round.
- No arrangements. No simplified editions. No repeats.
- Contestants must play the cadenzas.

Glazunov, or a Concerto of comparable difficulty. 2. One virtuoso concert piece, i.e. C.C. Saint-Saens, "Introduction and Rondo-Capriccioso", P. Sarasate or F. Waxman "Carmen-Fantasies, H. Wieniawski "Faust-Fantasy", "Variations on the Original Theme", or a piece of comparable difficulty of the contestants choice, or two caprices by N. Paganini, H. Violin Category B	One fast movement of a Concerto by J.S. Bach, W.A. Mozart, M. Bruch, E. Lalo, H. Wieniawski, or a concerto of a comparable difficulty. One virtuoso piece, Etude, or caprice of the contestant's choice, or two contrasting movements of a Sonata or Partitas by J.S. Bach.
Viola Category A	One movement of a Concerto from the standard viola repertoire such as J. Stamitz, F. Hoffmeister, A. Rolla, B. Bartok, P. Hindemith, or a Concerto of comparable difficulty. Prelude or two contrasting dances from Cello Suites by J.S. Bach, or a concert piece, or one caprice of the contestant's choice.
Viola Category B	One movement from Baroque Concerto or a Sonata by J.S. Bach, G.F. Telemann, A. Vivaldi or a work of comparable difficulty. A piece or Prelude from the standard viola repertoire of the contestant's choice, or two contrasting movements from Cello Suites by J.S. Bach.
